



Walking tour in the hills above Giverny (40 / 50 minutes)

The tour (in green on the map) starts on the side of the Village Hall.
 From Claude Monet's house : leave the house on your left and turn into the first street on the right (rue Blanche Hoschedé) then left at its end (i.e. along the Village Hall) The path starts 15 / 20 m farther down between a playground for children on the left and the "Musée de Mécanique Naturelle" (Museum of Natural Mechanics!) on the right.

After a short climb, the path follows the back gardens of Giverny houses. Farther on, the path seems to end when merging with a road from the left, very close to a house. (*) Turn immediately right uphill (this is the only steep part that may prove somewhat hard to climb) and 100 /150 m farther turn right again at the T-crossing (impossible to be mistaken) and you come back on a very nice path parallel to the first one but higher up the hill, with a beautiful panorama over the valley. Walk straight on until the path arrives at a country road. Turn right and walk down this road (very little traffic) and you are soon back at the Village Hall, from where you started.

(*) Possible extension : instead of going uphill, turn left down the road for 15 / 20m to find a path on the right, behind the gardens. Walk as far as you want and come back the same way to the road, on the left this time, and up the (fairly steep) path in front.
